League play starts on Monday, **October 18th, 2010 at 5 P.M.** at the Fort Rouge Curling Club. A big welcome back to all those that have returned for another good year of curling! Once again we are fortunate to have a full complement of 12 teams!

A Fee Increase per Usual!

The Fort Rouge Curling Club has increased our ice rental due to the improvements being made to the Club facilities. **Individual fees are up by \$10 per person at \$155 (\$620 per Team). Fees must be paid no later than November 1st 2010.** Please pay fees to our new Secretary-treasurer, Ralph Sanders or our President, Neil Carroll. Reminders

- The Four Rock Free Guard Zone rule is in effect.
- Spares must play Lead. If you have 2 Spares, they must play Lead and Second.
- Games start at 5 P.M. sharp and finish by 7 P.M. Be on the ice promptly at 5 to allow games to end on time! Time does not allow for team meetings with the skip to discuss shots. Be in the hack ready to throw your rock to speed up play.
- If a Team is late it will cost them 1 point for each 10 minutes late and a forfeit after 30 minutes.
- Game Results must be recorded on the sheet on the bulletin board following each game.
